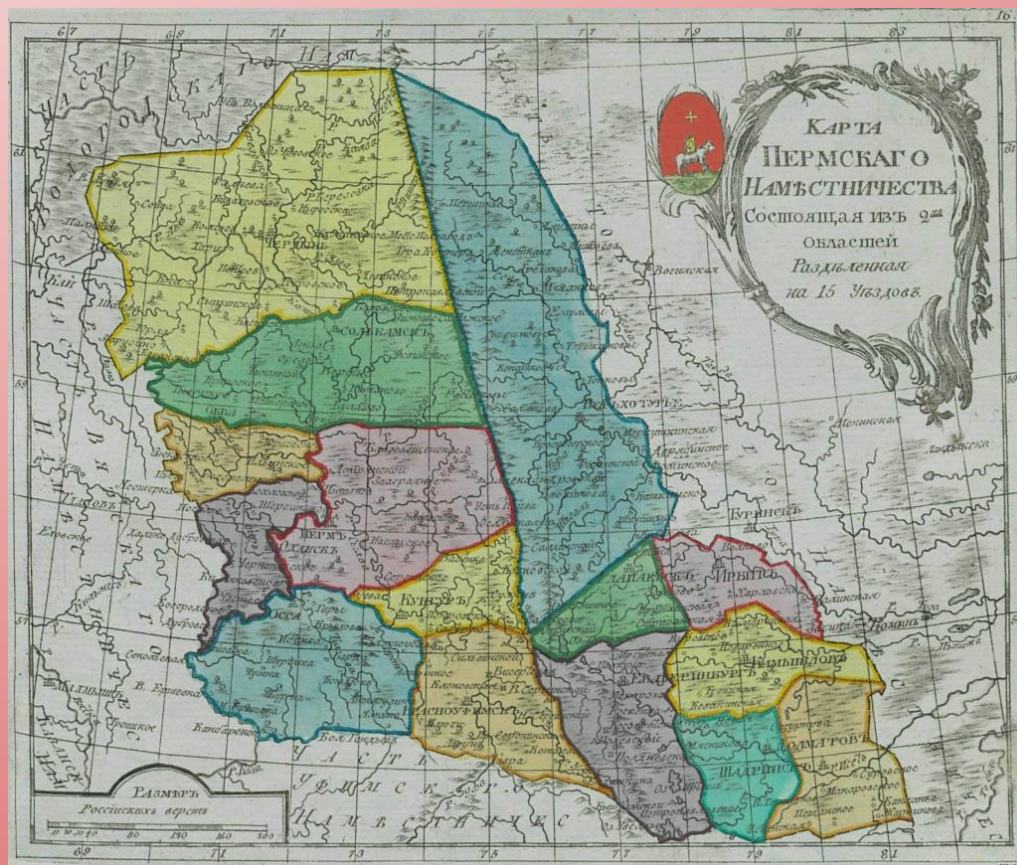

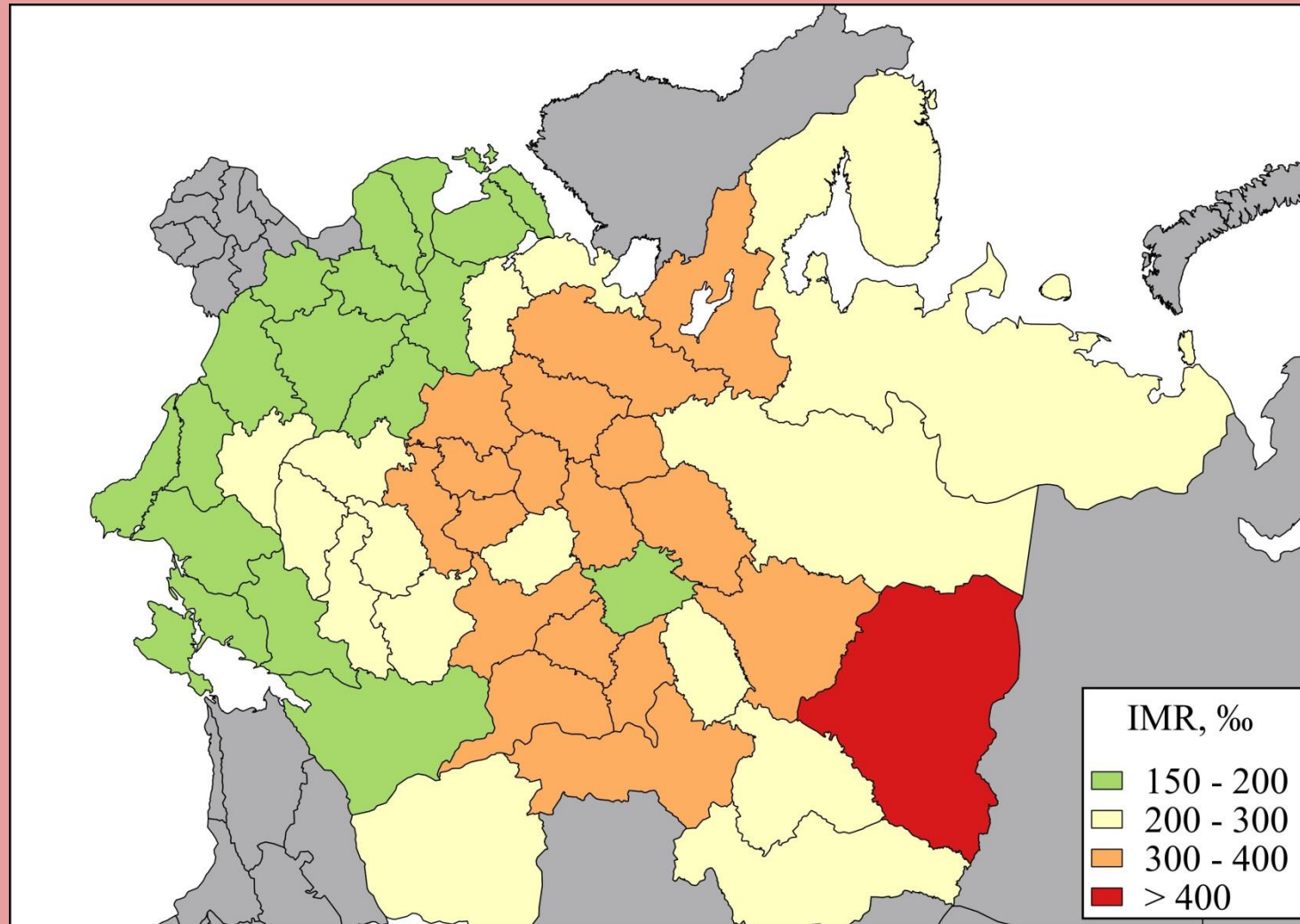

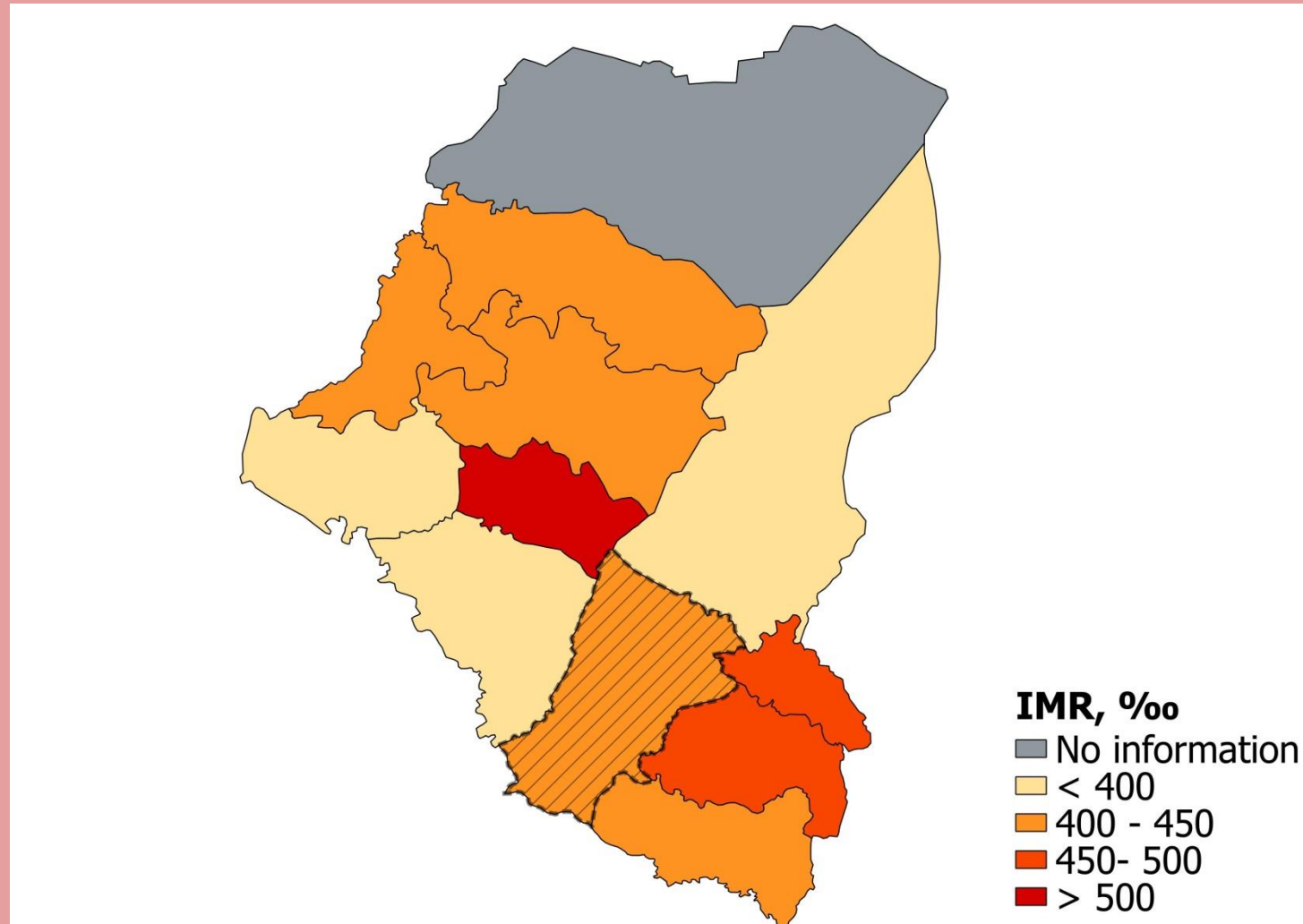

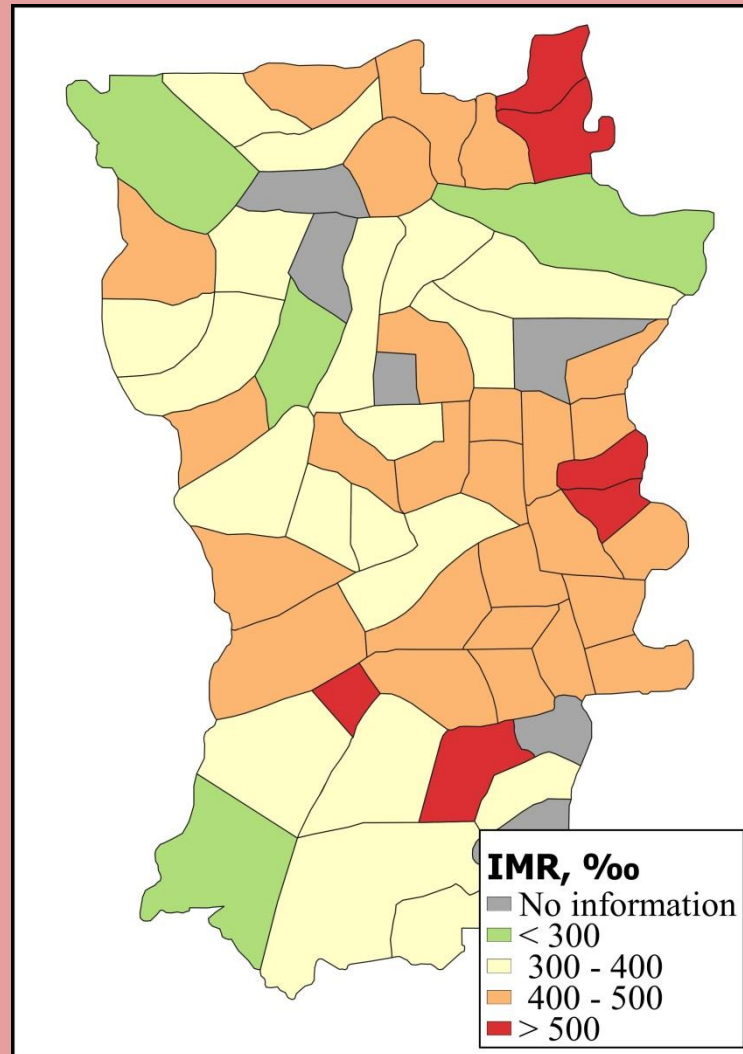
Russian Empire's European provinces IMR, 1893-1896



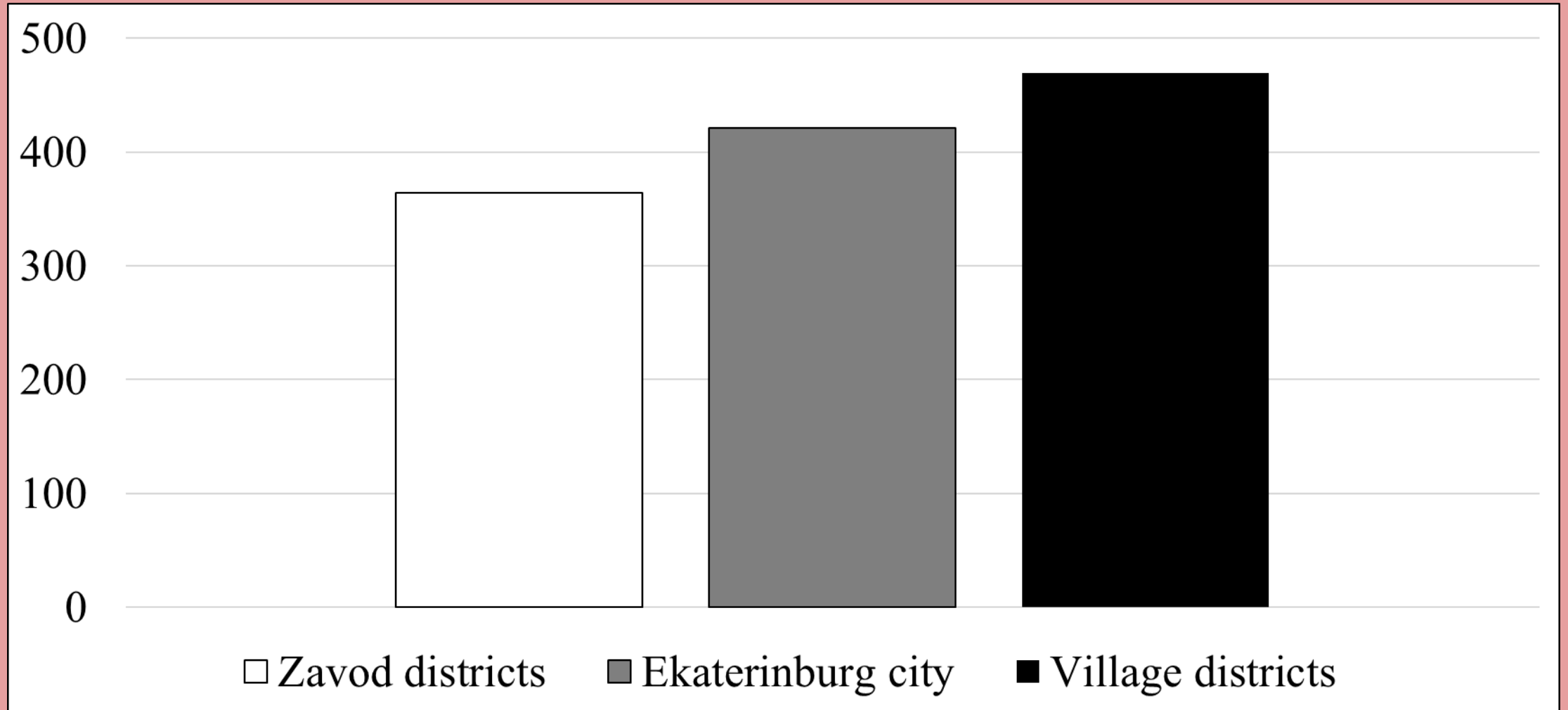
Perm' province counties IMR, 1891-1900
